¹;(a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code,

² **Section 324. Budgetary Requirements.** - The budgets of local government units for any fiscal year shall comply with the following requirements:

(c) In the case of provinces, cities, and municipalities, aid to component barangays shall be provided in amounts of not less than One thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per barangay;

ORDINANCE No. 2026-06

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A YEARLY FINANCIAL AID TO EVERY BARANGAY WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF JAVIER, LEYTE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THERETO.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A 7160) provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied thereto, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient, effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support amongst other, maintain peace and order, preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants ;

WHEREAS, Section 324 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) provides to wit :

Section 324. Budgetary Requirements- The Budgets of local government units for any fiscal year shall comply with the following requirements :

c) In the case of provinces, cities and municipalities, aid to the component barangays shall be provided in amounts of not less than One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.0) per Barangay ; x x x

WHEREAS, in order to augment the existing aid to the barangays that is One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00), there is a need to adjust the same equally for the 28 Barangays ;

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Javier, Leyte, **THAT :**

SECTION 1. Financial Aid – A Financial Aid is hereby given to every Barangay of Javier, Leyte, every year in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P 50,000.00).

SECTION 2. Authorization- The Municipal Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement and administer this Ordinance. Further, at any time, the Municipal Mayor may in his discretion adjust the amounts specified herein or terminate or cease the granting of financial assistance under this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Appropriation – The Municipal Government of Javier, Leyte, through the Municipal Budget Officer, shall ensure that appropriate amount for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be charged against Municipal Funds in accordance with the pertinent provision of R.A. 7160.

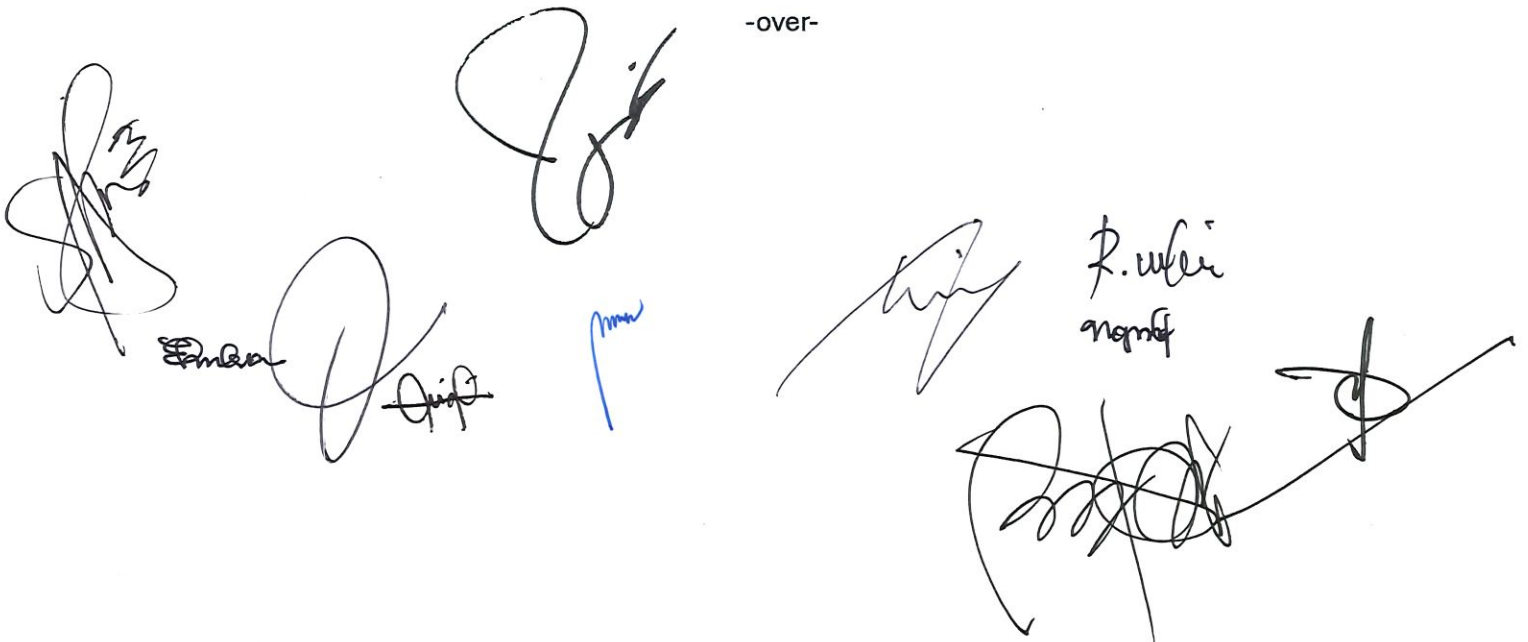
SECTION 4. Schedule of Released – The release of the Financial Aid shall not be later than June 30 of the budget year.

SECTION 5. Dissemination of Information – Copy of this Ordinance shall be furnished to the Honorable Municipal Mayor, Office of the Municipal Budget Officer, Municipal Treasurer, Municipal Planning and Development Office, Municipal Accountant and Municipal Resident Commission on Audit (COA) Auditor, for their information and appropriate actions.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause – If for any reason, a part of this Ordinance is declared illegal or invalid, other parts or provision hereof which are not affected hereby shall remain valid and in full force in effect.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause- All Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Order and administrative regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity Clause – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall remain effective every year thereafter unless sooner terminated.
